May 22 — Garlic Mustard Pull

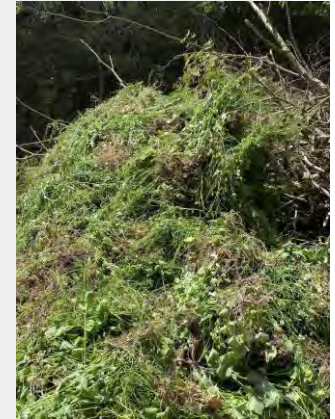
Plant Pull 2023 yielded almost 500 lbs of garlic mustard being hauled to the shale pit (and much of it came from Summit Road)!
